2019 Code of Conduct

Adults/ parents play a critical role in supporting their children in sports. These codes of conduct convey the importance of the parent/adult as a role model for good sportsmanship, fair play and integrity as they support their children in team sports. Parents and participants must read and sign this form prior to their child participating in our program. The mission of the Front Royal Midget Football League is to provide an opportunity for children of our surrounding area to participate in a safe and organized youth football program. The Front Royal Midget Football League Board Members has the authority to dismiss or take disciplinary actions towards a coach, adult, parent, participant, volunteer or spectator whose conduct is considered detrimental to the FRMFL organization. The appropriate Board Member will notify the person(s) of the cause action.

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

I do hereby agree to abide by the Front Royal Midget Football Leagues' Players Code of Conduct as well as to the discretionary authority given all authorized coaches in the program. Failure to follow the code or coach's instruction will be deemed grounds for disciplinary actions and or dismissal from the team.

- I will attend all scheduled practices and games. If unable to do so, I will contact my coach beforehand.
- If I am multiple absences, it will result in loss of playing time. 3) I will respect all coaches all times, 4) I will work hard in school.
- I will respect and obey my parents/guardian.
- I will respect referees and opponent players and coaches at all times.
- I will have sportsmanship as my number one priority in all games and practices.
- If I have an unsportsmanlike event, it will result in my immediate removal from the game. If I have an unsportsmanlike event that is a result of poor interaction with a referee, it will result in my immediate removal from the game. At the end of which Coach, Parent, and Player will discuss further consequences of the unsportsmanlike event.
- I will not use profanity.
- I will encourage my teammates in a positive way, regardless of circumstances.
- I will respect, protect, and maintain my equipment.
- I will conduct myself in a way that presents a positive image of FRMFL and myself on and off the field.

PARENT'S / SPECTATOR'S CODE OF CONDUCT

The Front Royal Midget Football League strives at being the best, in providing a positive sportsmanship environment for our players. Our program is bigger than any one player, coach, parent, or spectator.

- Encourage members of both teams.
- Keep all comments positive.
- Only players and coaches allowed on field, no exceptions.
- Leave the coaching to the coaches.
- Criticizing the officials, coaches and opponents will not be tolerated at all. The same goes for abusive language or cursing. Individuals will be given one warning for inappropriate activity. Individuals that continue; will be asked to leave the fields and the player will be removed from the game until the spectator/parent has left. Other sanctions as deemed necessary by the president or board may be enforced, including permanent ban. All decisions are final; there will be no hearing or appeals
- You are responsible for all family members and friends attending the games to watch your child.
- No open alcoholic beverages on fields or parking areas.
